



Alberta Recycling's Collection Site Awards of Excellence were introduced in 2008 to recognize municipal sites registered with the recycling programs that provide residents with environmentally safe, convenient and accessible areas to recycle their end-of-life electronics, paint and tires.

- Three awards are issued annually based on the population served:
 - Small: under 5,000
 - Medium: 5,000 – 25,000
 - Large: over 25,000
- Alberta Recycling's Field Services Inspector conducts annual inspections of all registered electronics, paint and tire collection sites. These inspections help ensure sites meet Program requirements and also enable Alberta Recycling to select the award winners.
- Following is a summary on what does it take for your site to become a winner (please see the Site Requirements documents at <http://www.albertarecycling.ca/collection-sites> for more information):
 - Make sure your sites are registered with the [Electronics](#), [Paint](#) and [Tire](#) Recycling Programs
 - Install the Program signage provided by Alberta Recycling
 - Ensure safe and proper handling of Program material
 - Ensure secure storage of Program material to prevent theft, scavenging and vandalism
 - Be convenient and accessible to the public
 - Perform unit counts of electronics
 - Keep eligible and ineligible materials stored separately
 - Maximize the capacity of paint bins
 - Submit collection site incentive reports regularly
 - Keep the site neat and orderly
 - Promote the collection sites in your community (see [Registered Municipal Collection Sites Advertising Grant](#) for funding assistance to promote your sites)
