



## Commercial Paint Roundup at Shepard Landfill – May 12, 2017

Commercial painting businesses can drop off their leftover volumes of commercial paint at the **Shepard Waste Management Facility on Friday, May 12 from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.**

The Shepard Waste Management Facility is located at 12111 – 68 Street S.E. [Driving directions to the facility are available on calgary.ca/waste](http://calgary.ca/waste). When you arrive at the scalehouse you will be directed to the paint transfer site.

### PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- **All paint containers must be sealed.** You are responsible for appropriate packaging of all materials.
- **You will be required to unload all materials yourself,** under the supervision of site staff.
- If you need assistance with unloading then you will be required to sign a waiver at the paint transfer site.
- **Do not bring any type of hazardous waste.**
- Only qualified paint and paint containers approved under Alberta's Paint Recycling Program are acceptable. Any unacceptable materials will be returned to you.

**The commercial paint roundup will not accept unsold paints such as mis-tints or write-off paint products. See the full list of [eligible and ineligible materials](#) outlined on Alberta Recycling's website, [albertarecycling.ca](http://albertarecycling.ca).**

This roundup is only open to commercial painting businesses or companies that purchase large volumes of paint. Retail paint companies or paint distributors are required to deal directly with paint processors registered with Alberta Recycling. **A list of [Registered Paint Processors](#) is outlined on Alberta Recycling's website.**
