

FREE COMMERCIAL PAINT RECYCLING EVENTS IN RED DEER

Address Correction

Commercial painters and businesses in general can recycle their leftover paint, spray paints, and empty paint containers at the following 2021 Spring and Fall Commercial Paint Roundups:

Thursday May 6, and Thursday October 7
9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (both dates)
7667 - 50th Avenue (Cloverdale Paint), Red Deer

Event details

1. Look for the white signs indicating *Commercial Paint Roundup*.
2. **Special Instructions re: COVID-19 to keep you and everyone else safe:**
 - a. If you are showing COVID-19 symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat), do not come to the event for the sake of your own health and that of others.
 - b. Practice physical distancing, keeping at least 2 metres from others including when interacting with staff and unloading your paint.
 - c. You may be required to unload your own material so please come with proper PPE; staff will be there to direct you.
 - d. Plan for extra time at the event as there will be longer wait times to ensure everyone is kept as safe as possible. Your patience will be greatly appreciated.
3. There is no charge or limit to the amount of eligible paint and paint containers that can be dropped off.
4. If you are a supplier dropping off unsold paint (i.e. new/unopened containers), please be prepared to provide verification that the recycling fee has been paid on the products.
5. The following products approved under Alberta's Paint Recycling Program are accepted:
 - Latex, water-based and oil-based paint
incl.
 - Stains, varnishes, and lacquers
 - Mineral spirits and paint thinners
 - Primers, sealers, undercoats
 - Deck cleaners, wood preservatives and paint strippers
 - Aerosol paint cans
 - Empty paint cans

Non-eligible paint material e.g. propane tanks, anti-freeze, batteries will not be accepted - they will all be returned to you along with any other unacceptable materials.
