

## Alberta’s Used Oil Recycling Program Products, Definitions and Environmental Fees

The following table helps clarify which oil materials should be charged environmental fees when sold or supplied in or into Alberta, and which products should not be charged.

<b>Lubricating Oil</b>	<b><i>\$0.06 per litre</i></b>
<b>Oil Containers</b>	<p><b><i>\$0.12 per litre/container size for containers made of high-density polyethylene (HDPE) or metal materials.</i></b></p> <p><b><i>\$0.20 per litre/container size for containers made of non-HDPE or non-metal materials.</i></b></p>
<b>Oil Filters</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Less than 8 inches or sump type filters</li> <li>• Equal to or greater than 8 inches</li> </ul>	<p><b><i>\$0.55</i></b></p> <p><b><i>\$1.25</i></b></p>

Automotive	Cars, Light Trucks, Medium Duty, and Heavy-Duty Trucks, Buses and Motorhomes/Recreational Vehicles
Electrical Equipment	Transformers, Capacitors, Mobile/Portable Light Towers, Generators, Compressors, Auxiliary Power Unit (APU)
Riding Mowers and Utility Vehicles	Commercial use only, up until July 1, 2020, when all riding mowers became Program eligible
Agriculture Equipment	Combine, Forage Harvesters, Tractor, Wind Rowers, Aerators, Balers
Construction Equipment	Dozer, Dumper, Excavator, Grader, Horizontal Direction Drills, Kg. Pipe Layers, Rollers, Kg. Rollers, Scrapers, Trenchers, Dredgers, Power Shovel, Reclaimer, Backhoe, Pipelayer/Sideboom and Compaction Equipment
Forestry Equipment	Attachments (Planting, Site Preparation), Feller, Feller Bunchers, Harvesters, Log. Loaders, Processors, Slashers, Skidders, Yarder, and Forwarder
Recreational (effective July 1, 2020)	ATVs, Motorcycles, Utility Vehicles/Side-by-Sides, Snowmobiles, Personal Watercraft, Boats, Golf Carts, etc.
Specialized Equipment (effective July 1, 2020)	Airport/Tarmac Vehicles/Equipment, Mining, Military Equipment, Emergency Vehicles, Miscellaneous Rental Equipment, etc.
